BLUE TREES PROJECT

Think 360 Arts partnered with the Denver Theatre District to bring Konstantin Dimopoulos' Blue Trees

public art project to Denver, where students from five Denver schools painted trees at their schools a bright shade of blue to highlight their vital role in our environment. Over 150 trees were also painted during the Blue Trees Family Day at Skyline Park in downtown Denver.

INSTITUTE FOR CREATIVE TEACHING

Think 360 Teaching Artists continued their partnership with the University of Denver's Morgridge College of Education to teach educators arts integration theory and

CREATIVE AGING PROGRAM

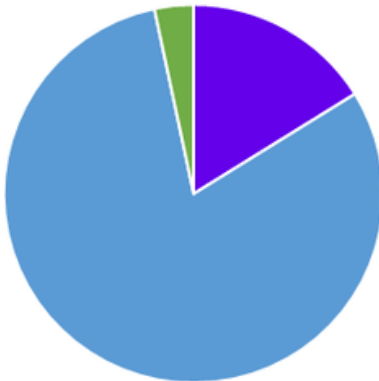
Established in 2016, the Think 360 Arts Creative Aging program infuses quality arts programs in
