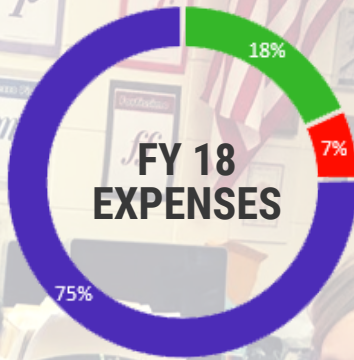

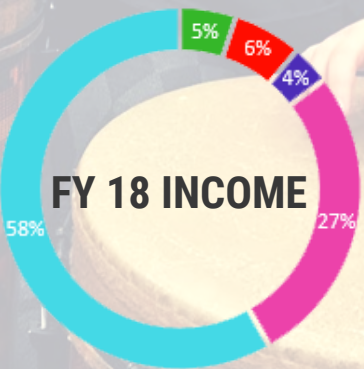

## DENVER COMIC CON

Think 360 Arts participated for the first time at Denver Comic Con 2018. Led by Think 360 Arts Teaching Artists at the Kids Lab, attendees made LED Light Sabers with Eureka's, screen printed a comic inspired image with Ink Lounge, painted in virtual reality with Denver Arts + Technology Advancement (DATA), did pop art print making with Jennifer Ghormley, and experienced one of Nicole Banowetz's inflatable sculptures up close.
