


think 360 2011 REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY

We are delighted to share highlights of this past year. Numbers alone can't convey the impact of our work. Every day wonderful things happen in schools where our teaching artists bring their energy, enthusiasm and mastery, and in schools where classroom teachers have learned to integrate arts into their lesson plans.



Programs in Schools

This year we implemented performances, workshops, and residencies for students in pre-schools, elementary, middle, high schools, libraries, recreation centers, and youth diversion programs. 40% of the schools we served are Title I schools.

Educator Professional Development

Our signature professional development program is the Aesthetic Education Institute of Colorado, where participants learn how to engage learners through the arts by putting cutting edge theory into practice. This year we trained 63 educators who in turn directly impact over 3,000 students on a weekly basis, quite literally bringing the arts to life for thousands of Colorado youth.

Artist Roster

Our roster is unique in the breadth of disciplines and depth of artistic experience represented - dance, music, photography, theatre, creative writing, sculpture, and more. Each artist brings a lifetime of artistic expression and discipline to our classrooms.

Partnerships and Collaborations

Our partnerships with Colorado Creative industries (formerly Colorado Council on the Arts) and the University of Northern Colorado's Center for the Integration of Arts Education are the basis for our work with schools and educators throughout the state.
